**Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**



Jesus stepped beyond social expectation in a way that opposed social norms. The carpenter became the minister.

The nobody became a somebody. More important, his rise came at the cost of others' reputation and power (namely, the traditional religious leaders). Jesus challenged the status quo with his message and his power. He preached the Kingdom. His actions showed the Kingdom at work. His work superseded that of the religious elite.

Jesus was unusual, even to the point of causing scandal and shame to his family. But Jesus, his message, and his mission pointed to something greater than social norms and people's expectations. They revealed the Kingdom.

Our problem, of course, lies in our expectations. What do we expect from others? How do we react when God or others don't meet our expectations? More important, how do we react when God or others CHALLENGE our expectations?

Join us as we discover and celebrate what Vatican II called the "source and summit of the Christian life". Bishop Barron speaks of the eyes of faith, and how we can see the priest, acting in the Person of Christ and speaking Christ's word at the consecration, acts to make Christ's presence real in the Eucharist. Jesus, as part of the triune God, has the power to create and to transform reality at its deepest level simply by speaking. Transubstantiation does not change the appearance of the bread and wine, but on the deepest level of their reality, they have been changed into the Body and Blood of Christ.

Therefore, we are sanctified and readied for eternal life in the Father through our communion with Christ's divine life in the Eucharist. **The Real Presence** unites the Church as the Body of Christ and thereby makes us signs of Christ in the world.

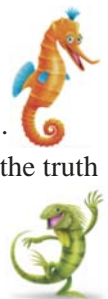
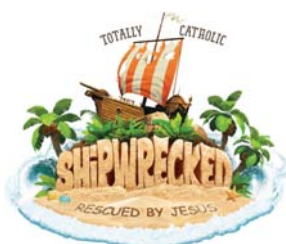


### Holy Cross School Mass

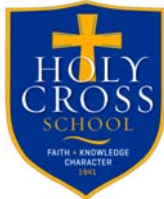
